KEY EVENT INFORMATION

- Bermuda will be the fifth stop of the 2026 Rolex SailGP Championship, with more than 5,000 spectators expected across the weekend.
- The event will shine a global spotlight on Bermuda, promoting the island's capabilities, beauty and status as a top global sailing destination.
- Fans can expect fast, physical and unpredictable racing, with identical F50 foiling catamarans reaching speeds up to 100 km/h and ensuring every race is tightly contested from start to finish – with national pride, personal glory and the sport's top prize (U.S. \$12.8 million) all on the line.
- Bermuda offers some of the world's best racing conditions on the Rolex SailGP Championship calendar with its crystal-clear waters and breezy conditions.
- Fans in Bermuda will be right on the water's edge, perfectly positioned in the race stadium with prime views, live commentary and food, beverage and merchandise available for purchase.
- This year, spectators will enjoy an upgraded on-land viewing experience at Morgan's Point, including Waterfront Viewing with elevated seating for the first time.
- The last Bermuda Sail Grand Prix in May 2024 garnered an economic impact of \$4.9 million for the island.
- SailGP and Goslings have announced a three-season, multi-event partnership to name Goslings the Official Rum and Ginger Beer Supplier across select SailGP events for the next three seasons, starting at the 2026 Apex Bermuda Sail Grand Prix.
- Through our partnership with Goslings, SailGP will elevate the fan experience in Bermuda through premium beverage offerings and curated musical performances from DJ Rusty G and Kasie Cains.
- The BONDS Flying Roos enter the event in first place on the season leaderboard after capturing the most recent event title in Rio.
- 12 of 13 teams will compete in Bermuda, with the Black Foils New Zealand SailGP Team not on the start line due to extensive ongoing repairs.
- Apex Group will serve as Title Partner of the Apex Group Bermuda Sail Grand Prix, reinforcing its longstanding commitment to SailGP and its continued support since 2024. WEEKEND PREVIEW

KEY EVENT NARRATIVES

BERMUDA RETURNS TO CENTER STAGE – A HIGH-SPEED SHOWDOWN ON ICONIC WATERS

The Rolex SailGP championship returns to Bermuda, a venue synonymous with elite foiling performance and tight, tactical racing. With its crystal-clear waters and unpredictable breezy conditions, Bermuda has historically delivered some of the most dramatic moments in SailGP history. Teams will need to balance aggression with precision as they navigate a course that rewards clean starts and punishes even the smallest mistakes. With the season beginning to take shape, every point earned in Bermuda will carry increasing weight. Twelve teams will compete once again, with the Black Foils still out of action after the team's Auckland crash.

BONDS FLYING ROOS LOOK TO EXTEND THEIR GRIP AT THE TOP

Australia's BONDS Flying Roos arrive in Bermuda riding a wave of consistency and confidence, firmly positioned at the top of the season's leaderboard. Known for their clinical execution and race management, the Flying Roos have turned strong starts into podium finishes throughout the season. In Bermuda, they'll be focused on maintaining that momentum and fending off a tightening pack, knowing that a commanding performance here could further cement their status as early championship favorites.

ARTEMIS RACING BUILDS MOMENTUM AFTER BREAKTHROUGH

Sweden's Artemis Racing head to Bermuda on a high after securing their first-ever SailGP podium in Rio. Driver Nathan Outteridge – an athlete very familiar with what Bermuda has to offer – called it “a big step in the right direction,” marking his first event final since returning to SailGP. With confidence growing, a strong showing for Artemis in Bermuda could be pivotal, transforming them from contenders into genuine title threats as the season intensifies.

LOS GALLOS ARE DEFENDING BERMUDA CHAMPIONS

After a mixed start to the season, Spain's Los Gallos are finding their rhythm at the perfect time. The team has climbed back into contention, signaling a resurgence that could shake up the standings. Spain won the last time SailGP raced in Bermuda in 2024, and returning there presents an opportunity to build on their current progress, with the Spanish crew aiming to turn recent gains into a statement result against the league's front runners.

EMIRATES GBR AIM TO BOUNCE BACK

The Emirates Great Britain SailGP Team arrive in Bermuda seeking a reset after a shock result in Rio. Championship leaders heading into the event, the British crew endured a rare off weekend, finishing last and leaving without a point. Driver Dylan Fletcher admitted the team “didn't sail well enough,” but with a strong season overall and proven success at this venue, Emirates GBR will be focused on a quick rebound to try to defend their Rolex SailGP Championship title.
